Target Population: Is the target population in alignment with serving and/or impacting the communities that have been the most disrupted? Does the application’s target population fall in alignment with the qualified census tracts?	25
Goals and objectives of the program/ project.	20
Project/Program demonstrates collaboration with other community organizations or stakeholders.	5
Supporting Documentation: All supporting documentation has been submitted and supports information contained in the application.	5
